### **2019-20 Academic Year**

Looking ahead to the new academic year, we want to give existing children the option to increase sessions before offers are made to new applications. Therefore, please complete a change of session form so we can plan ahead. Any planned increase, even for Spring or Summer terms 2020 would be helpful. If you are on a waiting list for another pre-school or nursery, please let us know, as this is helpful when organising admissions from September. A reminder that our notice period is half a term, **otherwise payment will be due in lieu of notice.**

### **New School**

This term we will be preparing for the children leaving in the following way:

- Doing lots of work with the children to prepare them for the transition to school,
- Liaising with the schools to share information on the children.
- Holding a transition talk on 18<sup>th</sup> June for parents, so you know how best to support your child. Look out for further details on this. - Invite reception teachers in to The Ark to see the children in their familiar setting.



### **Stay and Play week - w/c 20<sup>th</sup> May**

We will be holding a Stay and Play week in the week commencing 20<sup>th</sup> May. There will be a sign-up sheet so you can sign up to spend time with your child and us all during an Ark session. If you bring your sibling with you please ensure you are responsible for them at all times.

### **Reducing waste at The Ark Pre-school**

We continue to try to support Crowthorne's aim to become plastic free. Please remember bring in your milk bottle tops and trigger sprays for recycling.

When plastic boxes are brought home with cooking please wash and return them. A replacement can be bought for 50p, or you can supply a replacement.

Other ways we are reducing plastics are: We are reducing use of nappy sacks by only using them for soiled nappies; we will only use wipes for nappy changing; we reuse all our plastic wallets and only laminate what is required; archived paperwork is taken out of wallets before filing.



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## Mobile Phones at The Ark

Please can we remind all parents/ carers that we cannot allow the use of mobile phones inside the Ark hall or playground. This is for safeguarding reasons, to avoid the risk of unauthorised photos being taken of our children. The directive has come from Bracknell Forest Early Years Team, and is being judged by Ofsted under their safeguarding monitoring, so please help us to adhere to our policy. If another adult picks up your child please tell them about our policy to avoid embarrassment.



## Parent Survey 2019

We are issuing our annual parent survey, which is important to gain feedback from parents and carers, as part of our ongoing attempt to keep improving our provision. ## 30 hours' Free Childcare

If your child is turning 3 before 31<sup>st</sup> August 2019 you will be eligible for universal funding of 15 hours free childcare. You may also be eligible for 30 hours free childcare but you must apply for this. The deadline for this is 31<sup>st</sup> August but please apply as soon as possible so we can process it before the end of term.

See <https://childcare-support.tax.service.gov.uk/par/app/applynow> for 30 hours. We must obtain the 30 hours' code and verify it before the deadline in order to claim your free hours for you. These 30 hours can be shared across two settings (i.e. The Ark and another pre-school or a childminder). Please contact Sarah if you have queries or want more information.

Please remember that if you have a code, **you must check this every 3 months** to maintain eligibility.

## Summer Weather

In the hope that the summer term will actually bring summer weather, please can we remind parents to include a hat and a change of clothes (in the event of clothes getting wet with water play) in their bags. Please also apply sun-cream to your child before dropping them at The Ark.



## Eating at The Ark

Please can children NOT eat at The Ark prior to the start of the session. It is a better start for them to come in having eaten and does not cause issues with other children wanting food, or allergies amongst our cohort. All children will then have their snack together at snack time.
