### School Applications

All parents with children who were born between 1<sup>st</sup> September 2017 and 31<sup>st</sup> August 2018 (living in Bracknell Forest) will be able to apply for a school place from 5<sup>th</sup> November 2021 for your child to start school in September 2022. ## Clothing

As the weather becomes colder, please ensure that your child has appropriate warm clothing (coats, hats, gloves). Full waterproofs and wellies are also a good idea on Tuesdays and Thursdays this term as the children like to splash in puddles and climb on wet logs.

Next term our Fun in the Forest days will be on Monday and Friday.

If the weather is very unpleasant, we will walk straight back to The Ark. In the case of extremely severe weather we will text to let you know to drop off to The Ark instead but generally we will aim to continue with the planned sessions even in the winter months.

Painting – We try to put aprons on the children but sometimes they refuse or we don't get to them before they start painting. Please dress your child in old clothes or at least not their best clothes for The Ark to avoid special clothes being spoilt!

## Fun in the Forest Volunteer Needed

We have been very grateful to volunteers from the church who have helped to walk the children back from Wellington on our Fun in the Forest Days. We do have a gap on the rota so if you would be willing to come and meet us at Wellington (Byron Drive entrance) around 11:30am and help walk the children back up to The Ark a couple of times a month, please do let Naomi know.

## Christmas events

ALL Ark children are invited to take part in both Christmas events.

- **Monday 13<sup>th</sup> December – 9.30am – Nativity Service in the Baptist Church**

We will allocate parts for the nativity play, so will ask nearer the time who will be attending this event and will give details of costumes needed. We will serve refreshments afterwards for parents and children. Monday children can return to The Ark to resume the session as normal afterwards.

- **Friday 17<sup>th</sup> December – 9.15am-12pm – Christmas Party in The Ark hall**

All children are invited to the party, which will include party games and a festive snack during the morning. Parents/carers are invited to join us from 11:40am to see the children welcome a special festive visitor and receive a gift from him. In order to help cover costs we ask for a £5 contribution per child. Parents can take children home at 12 noon.

## Parent – Keyworker Consultations – w/c 10<sup>th</sup> and 17<sup>th</sup> January

A schedule will be put out at the beginning of the Spring term so you can sign up for an appointment to meet with your child's keyworker. This is an opportunity to follow their progress and development. There will be appointments at the beginning and end of sessions during these two weeks (except on Mondays and Fridays when we are at Wellington).

## Absence of children

We require a phone call or a letter every day that your child cannot attend preschool. The local authority has asked us to keep this information, so please support us in this. Please phone THE ARK number (**07999 550674**) if your child is absent that day. If you know in advance of an absence, or if it is for a longer period of time we require a letter please. We reserve the right to contact parents if your child is absent and we have had no contact.
