

A Typical day at The Ark

Pre-session: Children arrive at the church and hang coats and bags in the lobby. They self-register by putting their animal name picture in the box. Lunchboxes and snacks should be clearly named and left in the labelled boxes.

	Activity:	This time will include:
9:15	 Children are welcomed into the hall. Children have time for free play in inside and outdoor play area. 	 Craft, cooking, sand, water, books, puzzles etc. Name writing and letters and sounds (older children)
10:30	 Tidy up time All join in with 'The Wiggle Song' (dancing and following actions). Children get into groups for Storytime. 	A Child is chosen to be 'Heather's Happy Helper' for the morning.
10:50	 Toilet/hand washing Children eat snack together at the tables. 	 Counting the number of children/ boys/ girls/ adults, using different languages. Discuss the weather, day of the week and month of the year. Letters and sounds
11:15	Physical play and indoor games	
11:45	Tidy up time	
11.55	Music	
12.05	Key worker groups	Sharing what the cuddly toys did when they visited children's homes
12:10	All sing 'Goodbye Song' and give out items in baskets.	
12:15	Open doors to dismiss to parents/ carers.	

- Throughout the morning the children will be encouraged to do activities which will aid their physical development.
- Two days a week we plan to be at Wellington College for Forest School. These days will change periodically so that all children have the opportunity to benefit from this experience.
